

## TAPI Integration Process

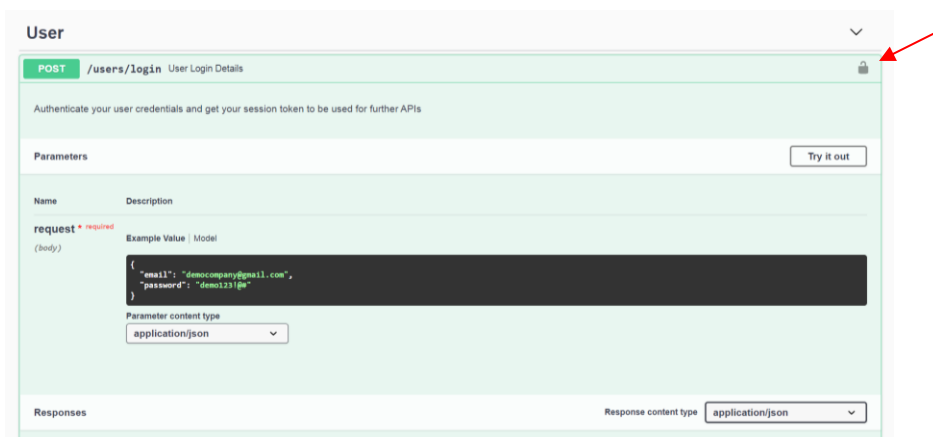
Livekeeping`s TAPI will help connect your existing Tally Data to any ERP, E-commerce Websites, Softwares, in a few simple steps.

Connecting Bookkeeping and accounting data to various platforms has been long and tedious task, using pre-existing API`s, Livekeeping TAPI will help you connect tally to various platforms automatically, helping you save a lot of time and resources.TAPI would require you to use client id and API id keys which will be provided by us within 24 hours of registration.

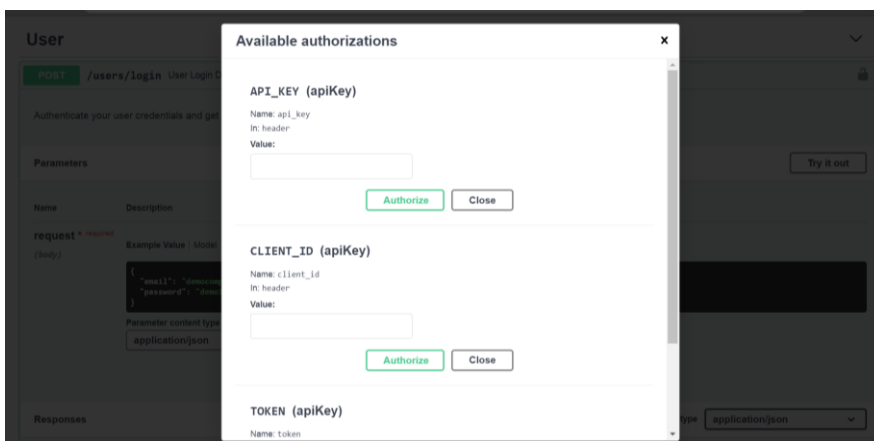
*Please Note: TAPI would require you to install and register in the Livekeeping Computer Application. In the Livekeeping Computer Application you are required to sync the desired tally company profiles, after which you can continue with API integration.*

### Steps for TAPI integration


**Step 1:** You would be required to authorise USER LOGIN, by clicking on the unlock button on the right corner, under the USER Header



**Step 2:** You would be required to input the client id key and the API Key provided by us in the unlock popup, which would let you generate a token no.



**Step 3:** After generating the token no., you will have to click on the try it out button and input your registered login ID and password of Livekeeping.





**Step 4:** In this you would be required to fill the client id, api id and token id in the master authorize button marked in green, on the top right screen of the home page
